MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Giving and Receiving

The two major elements of Christmas are giving and receiving. Without a proper heart neither can be done effectively.

October 5th Amy and I were the recipients of a tremendous gift, our daughter Elisabeth. The greater the value of the gift, often the harder it is to receive it. When the nurses handed Elisabeth to us instead of her birth mother in the delivery room I felt a sense of shock and awe! My mind immediately raced with compassion for the birth mother as I contemplated the sacrifice and love a young mother must have to give up her baby to relative strangers believing we will provide better for her child than she could. Receiving our daughter at birth truly was an indescribable experience.

No one in their right mind really believes they are worthy to receive a child from her mother. You ask the birth mother questions like, "Are you sure you really want to do this?", "Are you confident in your decision?" Underneath those questions are thoughts of why us? We really don't deserve this child. She is so precious, God help us to meet and exceed the best expectations for this child. I don't think words can express the emotions that flood the birth mother and the adoptive parents in a time like that.

Christmas is the right time to think about giving and receiving. We are all familiar with the baby Jesus lying in the manger. This humble picture painted in scripture reveals to the entire world the giving heart of a benevolent Father! Now consider the heavenly factors that went into allowing the manger scene. The world has a disease that is worse than the black plague, AIDS or any other disease known to man. The disease is called sin. It has infected the entire human race and without a cure the multitudes of humanity will be wasted as they are separated from God for all of Eternity.

November 2006 marked the end of our first year of ministering to the inmates at the Cass County Jail (CCJ), in Harrisonville Missouri. Earlier in the year Brian Hedges made me a licensed minister so that I could head up this ministry, which allowed him to step down from his commitment at CCJ. At that time, David Cundiff stepped up and became involved with ministering to the inmates, along with Paula Grant and I. David has been a blessing on many levels and to date he has delivered five different, prepared messages to the inmates. Paula also prepares messages that God lays on her heart to deliver to the ladies at CCJ. Paula is a rock to me in this ministry and I rely on her faithfulness and input heavily. Paula really connects with the ladies and is beginning some correspondence and discipleship with one or two of them.

In August of 2006, I met with Lieutenant Phillips, who oversees our volunteer ministry, and I gave him a written set of goals and objectives that HBF has at CCJ. Lieutenant Phillips was / is receptive of our ministry efforts in his facility and below are the three goals that I rehearsed with him:

- Goal #1 – Make disciples of those incarcerated as partial fulfillment of God's mission.
- Goal #2 – Equip the saints of God at Heartland Baptist Fellowship in the Word of God, through ministering to those who are incarcerated.
- Goal #3 – Unite the authority of God's Word with the Cass County authorities in bringing about change and reformation in the lives of those incarcerated.

I believe that all three of these goals are being accomplished at CCJ. We have received good feedback from the guards at CCJ about the change in behavior of the inmates and they think that it is related to the impact of our ministry. We feel that God has given us, and continues to give us, an open door at CCJ to share the Gospel and we see several souls each week make a profession of faith in Jesus Christ! In October 2006, Robert Frank began coming with us to CCJ and he too has been a real blessing to me and an asset to this ministry. Robert connects well with the inmates and has a good knowledge of the scriptures from which to counsel with. Robert's involvement allows us to see more inmates each week and also affords others of us to take a week off when necessary.

I have budgeted monies to provide the inmates with 200 Bibles in 2007. If you would like to contribute to the CCJ jail ministry, please designate that on your offering envelope. Also, please let me know if you would like to be involved personally in this ministry, we are thinking about having a training class to let people know what we do and what they could expect if they were involved. We are also in the planning stages of starting a faith based, addiction recovery program that we believe will be the bridge necessary, to transition those people who have made a profession of faith at CCJ, into HBF; so let David Cundiff or I know if you would be interested in helping with that. If you are not able to help directly with this ministry, perhaps you could help indirectly by committing to pray regularly for the CCJ ministry and for me to have wisdom in leading it. Lastly, let me say with Paul, "And I thank Christ Jesus our Lord, who hath enabled me, for that he counted me faithful, putting me into the ministry;" (1 Timothy 1:12). I think that Paula, David, and Robert also thank Christ Jesus that they have been enabled and counted faithful to have been put into the ministry too; all praise be to Christ our Lord.

FACILITIES TEAM

Work is progressing at the building site located at 283rd St., off 71 Highway. The foundation has been poured; the floor and the plumbing are done. Various parts of the sides have siding on and the roof has been started. The hydrant has been installed and Water District #4 has brought the water lines to the property. We were scheduled to pour concrete curbs for the "ADA" parking spaces in front of the building around December 9th, but the snow has postponed that project for now. Colors have been selected for carpet, tile floors, interior and exterior walls. The electric service has also been installed by Osage Valley Electric Company. The baptistry has been delivered while ongoing discussions are bringing decisions on lighting for the building and for the sound system.

Please feel free to visit the site and watch the progress as it takes place. There are many things that still need to be done, but we believe that God has that schedule under control.

Again, we are grateful for all the gifts that God has enabled you to give. As we are progressing through, our budget is getting a little tight; so we encourage you to continue to give as God prospers you.

Work In Progress

It has been wonderful to see the work of the building progress. Barring any major work stoppage we will inhabit our new building in the spring. The physical building serves to remind us of the spiritual construction of the believer.

From the foundation to the furnishings God is providing. Just as the work required to finish our physical building takes time the work to build the saints of God in the Word of God takes time and effort too. God has brought us all together in a mighty work of faith to build His church! It will get done because Jesus promises to build his church in Matthew 16:18.

In the mean time just as our building is a work in progress so our lives and the lives of those we minister to are works in progress. We must realize that God is fitly joining and framing the body together for the greater good of the gospel ministry. (Ephesians 2:21, 4:16)

No matter what stage of construction your life is in, you are welcome to come build your life upon the foundation of Christ. Some practical steps that will help you build upon the foundation of Christ include involvement in an adult class during B.I.B.L.E. (Biblical Instruction Believers Live Everyday) Hour. You should also consider meeting one on one or couple with couple and spend time growing together in God's Word through our Discipleship process. Whatever state of construction or destruction your life is in, be assured you are in the right place to allow God to bring all the pieces together so your life can be a thoroughly furnished for the Lord's residence. (Ephesians 2:22, 2 Timothy 3:17)
